

Riverwood Group offices closed on Code Red Days

The implications of the Fire Danger Ratings for people living, working and travelling in bushfire prone areas are significant, requiring careful examination.

Fire Danger Ratings are forecast by the Bureau of Meteorology during the fire season. They are based on weather and other environmental conditions and forecast up to four days in advance. The Fire Danger Rating predicts how a fire would behave if one started, including how difficult it would be to put out. The higher the rating, the more dangerous the conditions.
